Public Information: I'm starting off by apologizing for not having the new meeting schedules ready. I have just received the final version of the new meeting schedule. The bus signs have been purchased. SWINA has agreed to contribute 1/3 of the cost. This means ENNA will have 10 new signs and SWINA will have 5. My understanding is that SWINA will add the funds for the bus signs (\$167) to the payment of their portion of the Phone-Line bill. I would request that these funds be reimbursed to the PI subcommittee so that we can place our order for posters.

We have scheduled a Public Information Workshop for Saturday, November 3rd, starting at 1pm. Fliers are available. This is a fun, interactive workshop and we are encouraging all addicts to attend that can, not just those that are doing service work with the Public Information subcommittee. We need input from **everyone** to identify the needs of our Area so that, going forward, this subcommittee has some direction with future projects and where in our communities we should be focusing our efforts. Please encourage all addicts to stop by and give us their input. I will be requesting our monthly budgeted funds for July-Oct to pay for the following services:

\$35 x 4 months = \$140

\$65 - church rental for PI workshop

\$75 - to make up for the remainder of the \$250 cost for the poster project

We are also in the process of contacting Cox Communications in order to get an ad broadcasted on the Community Bulletin Board, Channel 22. The ad will be the same as what is posted on the bus signs. Good news - this service is FREE!!
