2008 Report

Greetings to ENNA from Close Encounters 2008,

As we close the doors on the 2008 convention and begin to plan for 2009, I want to take this opportunity to express our gratitude to our groups, service committees and most of all to our fellowship for the overwhelming show of support our committee experienced at the convention.

To say that we were surprised by the attendance and participation would be an understatement. Our best estimates place our weekend attendance at 500 addicts. This supports our belief that Close Encounters is truly the "friendliest little convention in the universe".

Our ending report would not be complete without a quick review of the year. I'll try to be brief. We knew, leaving the 2007 convention at Settle Inn, that Close Encounters had truly outgrown that facility. Our first and possibly most difficult task for 2008 was to find and secure a location that was large enough for us to grow and still stay affordable to the area. It took 3 months, but the hard paid off and we finally signed a contract with Crown Plaza Hotel. Now the work was to begin in earnest.

Our first fundraiser was the Clean Carnival. While it was well attended and the fellowship had a good time, it actually lost money. So we knew that our job was cut out for us to do a better planning job and to preplan better for the next fundraisers. Our tie-dye shirt sales were phenomenal. They always are so well received by the fellowship.

On the night of September 20th my pickup truck was broken into and my briefcase containing the convention cash card and the pin for the card was stolen. Three charges were incurred that night using the card and pin. The card was discovered stolen and a stop was issued the next day. The police were called and a report was filed.

The card was also used to purchase phone services (online gaming charges). The bank reversed the phone charges after the committee disputed them. The police report was presented to the bank to substantiate our dispute. I am including a copy of that police report with my report tonight.

The total amount that was charged on the stolen card and not recovered from the bank was \$405. This is detailed in our treasurer journal that will also accompany this report.

The NA Feud was held on September 22 at St. Matthew Church. The attendance was wonderful. We had teams from many of our ENNA groups and several from other areas. It was a great time and was a good fundraiser for us. We sold a lot of shirts and food and everyone loved the event.

The committee also sponsored the New Year Gala in 2007. We had a HUGE raffle and again we were amazed by the number of addicts who attended. I think HP might have been telling us all along that we were going to see more addicts than we had ever seen before at the convention, but we were just glad at that time that everyone enjoyed the evening and that our fellowship had a safe place to ring in the new year.

Our merchandise committee got very busy in January, ordering all of our wonderful "stuff". The refreshment committee began contacting home groups to sponsor the hospitality room and the response was incredible. Groups also stepped up to chair the marathon meetings. We were able to see our area unity totally in action.

And so here are the statistics for the convention itself:

Pre-registrations before the convention: 110

Total registrants at the convention: 335

Newcomers: 58

It should be of interest to our area that 36 newcomers brought in the newcomer registrations that we passed out at area in January. A few of those registrations were unfortunately used by addicts who were not newcomers, but the ones that were given to newcomers at meetings did bring in many addicts who might not have otherwise attended. Thanks to the groups who took the time to help out.

We gave away 16 books at the main meeting on Saturday night.
The main speaker meeting was standing room only.

This is not to say that the convention was without problems. As many of you know, we were contacted by the hotel on the Monday following the convention. They let us know that some of our members were irresponsible, causing frustration and inconvenience not only to the hotel staff but also to the general public with whom we shared the hotel that weekend. Our committee takes responsibility for the fact that we were taken off guard by the overwhelming attendance and fell short of providing the added responsibilities that were needed to keep it all together. The bottom line is that Crown Plaza was unwilling to sign a contract with us for 2009.

The committee is forming a letter addressing this that will be sent to our members. One good thing that came from all of this is that already our committee for 2009 is twice as large as 2008 and we have begun plans that will go a long way to preventing this from occurring again.

Our HP does take care of us though, and the 2009 convention has already found a wonderful location. We believe that as an area and as a fellowship, we can and will work this all out.

Our treasury was audited on March 13th by our area treasurer, Joe W., Chris B. and Tami B. Our final treasurer's report is being submitted to the ASC.

So, with all that said, after subtracting our startup funds, the 2008 Close Encounters Convention Committee is turning over to ENNA ASC a check in the amount of \$4655.21. Two additional checks totaling \$256.29 will also be turned over to area for a grand total of \$4911.50.

Our committee met on March 7th to form the 2009 committee. We elected Heather V. as our 2009 chair, and have asked Tami B. to serve as treasurer again with Chris B. as vice-treasurer. This is a new position created as part of our plans to be a more effective committee. We would like the area to give a vote of confidence to all three at this time.

It has been our pleasure and our privilege to serve this area for the past year. We as a committee are gratified to be able to be a part of carrying the message to so many addicts.

We invite everyone to make plans to attend Close Encounters 2009 to be held February 27 thru March 1 at the Regency Lodge. Registration forms will be available at the April ASC. Save the date. We'll see you all there.
