-PUBLIC INFORMATION:

The Public Information subcommittee has voted to now be named the Public Relations subcommittee. We felt that this is a more recognizable name in our community and also more accurately describes the service work we provide: We are not

OLD BUSINESS:

MOTION:

Motion: To increase literature committee budget to \$4500.

Intent: To allow us to increase out stock on hand. Literature prices will go up this year and in order to maintain the same stock quantity, we will need to increase our budget. **Withdrawn**

MISAPPROPRIATION OF LITERATURE FUNDS TOPIC:

History: At the final audit of the literature stock and account on Sunday, January 13, 2008, it was determined that a deficit of \$1936.39 existed. The previous lit chair admitted misappropriating the funds. A contract was signed by Tina Mc. (prev. lit chair) and the ASC chair and treasurer stating that the funds would be repaid over a 2 year period at a rate of \$80.68 with the first payment due March 1.

Joe: No payments have been made and no attempt to communicate with me. I have left messages and have heard third party that she wanted to split the payment but no action on her part.

As I see it we have 3 options: 1. send a letter, 2. file in small claims court, 3. press criminal charges

John B.: option 4 would be to absolve the debt.

Stuart: Jim is in the hospital and they are in a grave financial condition.

Cari: That is a pretty large sum of money. Could we renegotiate the contract?

Dave W.: We have had no communication. No meeting attendance.

Karen: I've been out of work but my bills are due regardless. Would absolving the debt just enable them?

Mark: This is misappropriation of funds. Theft. A crime has been committed. Jim was working when the money was stolen. But we all know that they have had financial problems for a very long time. We gave her this position when they were financially unstable. We bear some responsibility. I'm confused.

Annie: Re: Legal issues, this would be a felony. It is over \$500. It is not a good idea to set a precedent that we will not hold trusted servants accountable.

John B.: What role did we play? What were the check and balances that would have prevented this from happening.

Sam: **JFT moves** to take 2 options back to the groups to decide. 1. Legal / criminal action or renegotiate the contract.
SNL: second

Jen D: Clarification of motion: Criminal or small claims?

Annie: Small claims will do a judgment and then garnish her wages.

Pete W.: Request to amend motion to add option to send a letter informing her of our intention to file criminal charges.

Cari: Request to amend motion to include all four options –

1. File a civil suit in small claims court
2. File criminal charges
3. Attempt to renegotiate the contract
4. Absolve debt.

Sam: JFT agrees to the amendment

Mark: **Motion to table** and take back to groups.

Vote: 17 yes, 1 abstain

MOTION

VOTE:

To give the groups the final say in determining the course of action that ASC should take.

The options are:

1. File a civil suit in small claims court.
2. File criminal charges with the county attorney.
3. Attempt to renegotiate the contract to a lesser payment and longer terms.

THEFT OF CLOSE ENCOUNTERS CASH CARD TOPIC

Mark B.: CE lost a large sum of money due to a theft (the CE cash card and pin along with the bank account info was stolen from the prev. CE chair's truck by unknown individual or individuals) The issue for me is that the ASC was never given the opportunity to decide what to do. The concepts way we are accountable as a whole. I think this is a done deal, the money is gone, but it is still not OK that the ASC did not know. I realize that is was in the financial report that Tami gave to Joe, but it was not included in the committee's written report.

Tami: We took direction on that decision from the previous ASC chair who told us it was committee business and that we did not need to bring it to ASC.

Joe: I saw a notation on the financial report but did not take time to really research the issue.

Stuart: Of course, Keith (previous ASC chair) knew and many others at the ASC knew about the theft. I did not try to hide the issue. I was totally wrong in keeping the records together. The total that was not recovered was \$405.

Jen D.: How was the card able to be used?

Stuart: The CE cash card and pin were kept in my portfolio and I left it in the truck.

Dave W.: What do we want to do?

Tami: We need to be aware that Stuart did file a police report and submitted it last area. He has been forthcoming about this.

Mark: We need to use this as a learning experience. The ASC chair cannot make decisions for the area about what will or will not be discussed by our area. The fact that he decided to keep it out of the area and area minutes was not OK.
