***H & I:**

I'm here to ask for your help, not only from this area but from all the groups in this area. I feel that I have failed as your chair for H&I and as this is just my feeling I see this as only my feeling. So back to asking for your help, you will find our H&I learning day flyer on the table. This is a regional learning day so here comes the help I am asking for: I need all GSR's to your groups and push this learning day. We need as many people trained as possible. ***PUBLIC INFORMATION:**

Wow! Things are really moving along for us.

We had the Gold Rush on June 28th. We visited over 100 locations and left meeting lists at approximately 40 of the locations. This means 400-500 extra meeting lists have been placed into the community that normally would not have gotten out. Of the remaining locations, 90% of them were closed and the rest we could not locate. Only 2 locations out of all of them actually refused the meeting lists. I think this shows that our community understands there is a need for addicts to get some help. We greatly appreciate everyone that helped out. It was truly a rewarding service experience. We already have a potential new facility for an H&I meeting. Dave and I will be meeting with one of the facilitators of the group home next week.

Our Fair Training Day was held on July 12th. It was very informative and it really helped show us how to respond to inquiries that we will be receiving when working at booths and doing presentations. As we have previously reported, we are trying to prepare for a booth at this year's SeptemberFest event at the Qwest Center. The cost of the booth is \$125 and we have the funds available from our monthly budget that we have saved. However, before we send the money to reserve the booth, we thought the cost was substantial enough that we should make sure the Area is ok with us using our funds to pay for the rental. If the Area feels that we can proceed, we will reserve the booth. We did have people from the Training Day sign up for some time slots for SeptemberFest so that we could continue our planning. We will need to get some additional support from the Fellowship to help man the booth. I am asking that if you have ever done any PR training in the past, or have ever assisted with any PR work, or if you know anyone who has, to let me know so we can see about getting all the time slots filled. There are 3- and 4-hour time slots scheduled throughout the weekend. Please let us know if you would have some time available to help out. The event is scheduled from Thursday, August 28th through Monday, September 1st. This is the SWINA campout weekend and we already have some Iowa folks that will be in town that have signed up and are willing to take a few hours out of the weekend to come help out.

New meeting lists have been printed and the bill has been submitted to the Area Treasurer for payment. Please feel free to pick some up for your groups.

We are pricing business cards to be handed out at different locations. Benson High School requested these and we think they would also be beneficial for government and medical offices. We could also use them for our booths and presentations. Slagle Printing, who prints our meeting lists, is working on a quote. We are also considering ordering card stock from World and stamping our Hotline and Web address on them. We feel that actual printed cards would be more professional but we are considering all cost options.

I sent a Regional report with Mark B. to advise them of our activities. We are looking forward to getting the Public Service Announcements they have recorded so that we can review them for our local radio stations.

Regarding old business, Jo Don's Sign Pro has been contacted several times for an inventory report on the bus signs; however, no response has been received. We will continue our efforts to get a report.
