### **Treasurer:**

Joe W.: We audited the literature on Sunday, January 13, 2008 in the community room at 3000 Farnam St. Annie W. had picked up the literature from the previous lit. chair earlier in the day. The previous lit chair had declined to do an ending audit.

The audit was conducted by several NA members. After several hours of counting and calculating, we have the following information:

\$ 2063.40 literature stockpile (books, keytags, medallions, IP's, etc.)

\$ 954.92 cash on hand and previous balance

\$ 954.71 outstanding balance (90 days) with WSO

This leaves a deficit of \$1936.39 below prudent.

The new chair agrees with the audit information. Joe W. and Annie W. met with the previous lit. chair and she agrees with the audit. A restitution agreement was drawn up for repayment of theft of NA funds. The agreement was signed by the prev. lit chair, and witnessed by Annie and signed by Joe. A copy was provided to the previous lit chair along with a copy of WSO Bulletin #30 Theft of NA Funds. (interested? You can download it from: <http://www.na.org/bulletins/bull30-r.htm>)

ASC as a whole needs to be aware that we bear substantial responsibility for the current situation. The lit. checking account had only one signer. There has not been an audit for over 2 years. We had gone for over a year without a full physical and financial accounting from the lit. committee. We can't allow this to happen again. The new account will have 4 signatures including the ASC chair and another member of the executive committee. WSO has agreed to let us send them \$900 toward the outstanding balance and we have decided that all orders placed in the immediate future will be made on a "cash" only basis. This means that we only order as much inventory as we have cash on hand to pay for. Literature has submitted a financial request to the ASC for \$1936.39 to bring the committee's prudent up to \$4000.00. A copy of the contract for repayment was given to the previous chair and a copy will be kept by the ASC treasurer. The first payment of \$80.68 is due March 1 and will continue for 24 months. A monthly accounting will be made by the treasurer at the ASC. In retrospect, all groups should have 2 signers on their accounts. No one person should be individually accountable for NA funds. All finances should be conducted by at least 2 people.

Jen D.: Can the ASC treasurer be the 2nd signer on a group's account?

Annie W.: yes

Mary R.: Could all financial business for the lit committee just be done by the ASC treasurer?

Tami B.: This would mean that the ASC treasurer would be doing double duty and that the lit committee would have to track him or her down to do business. It is imprudent to try to do the committee's work like that.

Carrie C.: When was the last audit?

Tami B.: Over 2 years ago.

Mark B.: It is my understanding that there were no checks that were misappropriated. Correct? "YES" Groups need to be aware that business should be done with checks and that our groups should establish checking accounts in order to be more accountable.

Butch: We need guidelines that state when an audit should be done for Lit.

Owen: Do all groups have checking accounts? No.

Carrie C.: Any group who starts an account should use the area EIN number. NOT any individuals SS#. Our group has had problems in the past and we learned to do differently.

Jenifer W.: The lit committee is working on new guidelines, but until then there will be a physical audit monthly. Want to help? Come by the committee meeting.

Annie: We have been trying to get a copy of the letter for the EIN through one of the banks currently being used by area groups.

Jenifer W.: I have a copy.

Annie: I will get copies made for anyone who needs one. Call me.
