**MINUTES:**

**CHAIR:** Annie – Glad to be here.

**ALT RCM:**

I attended the Regional meeting this last Saturday at Giltner. I carried the message of our activities and general goings on, along with our votes on the issues. Kevin C. was elected regional treasurer. The regional H and I budget was approved to be raised. Our area received the “traveling wand,” meaning that we took the largest number of “first timers” to region. NRCNA 26 - “Beyond our Wildest Dreams” Oct 2-4 in Lincoln; pre-reg fliers should be out this week. There were two nominations for regional secretary: Susan S. from Giltner 07-08-97 or Tami B. from Omaha 11-11-86. However, Tami has since withdrawn her name. There was a complaint at the regional level of activities that there is a lack of communication and that ENNA had no Activities representation. The only other issue was that the regions insurance policy had to be paid, which is \$1694, but there was only \$750 in the bank. This is due to over \$4000 that has not yet come back from NRCNA 25, which is not due back to region until January. Therefore, it was decided since the areas and groups of the region had already decided to take out the insurance, that everything possible would need to be done to pay for this. The solution was to opt to make four quarterly payments, which is allowed according to the terms of the insurance. Finally, the only other matter to be voted on would be whether or not region should send \$100 to zonal due to zonal going considerably below prudent reserve for the first time since it was established. The reason it went below was the last zonal function was poorly attended.

That being said, I appreciate the opportunity to be of service and it is with careful prayerful consideration and much regret that I have to inform this area of my inability to fulfill this service commitment beyond this meeting. I have talked to several people about this and truly feel it is the best decision for me and my circumstances at this point in time. For the record, this is against the advice of my sponsor, our RCM, who feels I should at least give this a month or two to think about. I feel that it is best to do this now, as I believe it is inevitable and doing it now will allow the area to try to find someone else before the next regional meeting. Again, thank you for your allowing me to be of service. It was a pleasure and a learning experience, even if it was only for a limited amount of time.

#### **PHONELINE:**

Dear ASC,

Since there is no attendance at the Phonline Subcommittee Meeting, I am bringing some issues to ASC. If you are interested in what is going on with the Phonline, please listen. The Subcommittee made a few decisions lately due to complaints. The complaints were that the carriers didn't want to have to write the phone number of the caller down in the log book when the call came in. So we decided that instead we would report how many calls came in a day and how the caller got the Phonline number and record that information. Now the carriers are complaining about recording that information. We need that information. We pass it on to PR to let them know what methods of information are being used to get the Phonline number to addicts. We also put together a binder with the flyers in it and put it in a bag. Carriers aren't carrying the bag. They say it's too big or it's too girly, so Tim L. is donating an NA bag to replace the one we are using. I don't know what to do about these problems. I can't carry the phone continuously. I depend on these people to be responsible, but they don't want to follow the guideline. Any suggestions would be helpful. Next, the 10 o'clock meeting in Council Bluffs never informed the Phonline of its existence, therefore one of the carriers did not let an addict know it was happening and there was a complaint from SWINA. First of all, if we don't get the information, we can't pass it on. Second of all, the phone should not be manned in that manner. We do not need babysitters. There will be a phonline training day on Saturday, November 8 at the Lighthouse at 1 o'clock. Hope to have a good turn out. Finally, and Tim L. will go into detail about this, SWINA has decided to vote me out of my chair position on the Phonline. I would like to discuss this in further detail during open discussion to find out how ENNA feels. Thank you for listening and any advise would be greatly appreciated.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **OPEN FORUM**

Monica T – SWINA wants to have me removed as phonline chair. They are asserting that I told a volunteer to answer the phonline correctly and that was not OK. That happened a year ago. Also they say that I am not referring callers to the Cisions of Hope meeting.

Joe – SWINA wants her removed as the chair of our subcommittee? Monica is OUR chair.

Jen D. – Does SWINA have a liaison now?

Monica – SWINA ASC did not ask Tim for a phonline report when he attended their ASC.

Mark – Our guidelines say that we elect a chair and that SWINA has a liaison.

Mike VP – When I reported to the SWINA ASC & my GSR's what was said at this ASC last month, they were livid at the lack of credence given to serious acts of misconduct. This is why this motion was brought forward. ENNA needs to take this seriously. SWINA wants a serious response. We pay 1/3 of the phonline bill and we want to be assured that things will be taken care of.

Annie – Did your groups vote on this?

Charlotte – This is an ongoing issue. Group conscience was not necessary, the GSR's already had their information.

SK – Paying the bill is one thing and doing the work is another. This is not a problem that can be fixed by throwing money at it. Carrying the hotline is hard work. The 7<sup>th</sup> tradition is about suiting up and showing up. I'm grateful that people are willing to do the hard work. What is SWINA doing to help except just throwing money at the issues and complaining?

Mark – We get focused on crime and punishment instead of being in the solution. Has SWINA offered a solution other than just looking at the personalities of the situation? What has SWINA done to address a solution? Have you attended the phonline subcommittee?

Mine VP – Chair and VC of phonline have left us in the lurch by leaving our ASC. We don't get any credence to our complaints. I am going to get trained to carry the phone.

Kerry W. – I'd like to hear solutions. I answered the phone when we had a pager and it's a hard job. I see the same 3 or 4 people with the hotline all the time.

Chris B – Does SWINA have a nomination? Should we have 2 phonelines?

Mark – Phonline and activities and H&I used to meet at the same time. It fostered a sense of unity. What if we tried that? Phonline could meet and SWINA could come. We all need to make sacrifices in our recovery to make it work.

SK – Phonline work is easier now. We need to support as best we can. It's about the newcomers.

Charlotte – We have addicts from eastern parts of our area who want to carry the phone.

Tim L. – I had the phone in Red Oak and Atlantic and I had service so that isn't an issue.

Amy – What are we doing right now?

Tami – What are your (SWINA) specific issues?

Charlotte – My home group's information is not being given to callers. This is a gross misuse of power.

Annie – Is there some solution other than just attacking personalities? This is not about personalities. This is not a pissing contest.

Kerrie W. – Did SWINA approve her as the chair?

Joe – Is there a motion? We are wasting our time unless there is some motion on the floor.

Heather – How can a motion from SWINA be voted on without group conscience?

Chris B. – My home group has directed me to make a motion that we separate phonelines. Seconded by Back to Basics.

Jen D. – I am going to take this information back to my home group. We have a lot of addicts who have issues. SWINA has brought their demands here and now ENNA needs to focus on getting a solution.

Charlotte – Tim did get to talk at ASC. My home group is dwindling because of the problems with the phonline. This misuse of power needs to be taken care of. Mike VP says he did try to attend phonline. Was not where he thought it was.

Tami – SWINA's web site has the information about the location and time posted on it.

Margi – Sorry that SWINA feels hurt. Did Mike VP tell SWINA that we thought that everyone on both sides needs to be more involved. There needs to be more training. Will SWINA attend the next subcommittee?

Mike VP – I told them about the "witch hunt" and the ASC just shut down.

Tami – Is Monica the only one who is bypassing the Visions of Hope meeting or is the whole phonline part of this?

Charlotte – All I know is that no new people are being referred and it is severely affecting my home group. I don't know who answered the phone when I called to test the phonline, but Mary R, Sandy, and myself have all called many times and the volunteer isn't giving good information.

Tami – Who is it who answered the phone?

Charlotte – I don't know.

Joe – We need to move on. What is the motion.
