

Requirements for becoming a signer on an ENNA ASC or sub-committee account

Identification:

Nebraska or Iowa driver's license or US passport

SS Card

Bank may require an additional form of ID (credit card, State issue ID, military ID, green card number, state or federal prison ID)

Past history that could be problematic:

Fraudulent activity on an account that would prevent you from being a signer on the account. (by the applicant or against the applicant)

Any outstanding fees or charges or unpaid checks on closed or suspended bank accounts will automatically disqualify you from being a signer on a bank account.

A history of continuous NSF (not sufficient funds) on an account may disqualify you from being a signer on a bank account.

Court order prohibiting establishing any bank interaction

Abilities necessary to effectively manage an account as a treasurer

Can manually balance an account to bank statement monthly

Keep accurate, current records of all transactions in a spreadsheet (either computer or paper)

Prepare and present all records for bi-annual audits by the ASC

Participate in annual budget planning (where applicable)

Questions for all treasurer nominees

Have you misappropriated funds from the fellowship?

If so, were amends made?

Are your personal finances stable enough to allow you to handle funds without issue?

Do you have any banking or personal issues that would preclude you from becoming a signer on a bank account? (This will not automatically disqualify you from being a treasurer)

Do you have or are you willing to learn the necessary skills to effectively manage a bank account?

Questions for all elected position nominees

Have you ever left a position in NA before your term was up?

If so, what were the circumstances?

If yes, what are your plans to make this position have a better outcome?

What prior positions have you held that would make this a spiritually fulfilling service experience?
